Use of vitamin D supplement for Vitamin D replete patients to prevent AD is not recommended.

More RCT study in this area is needed







- Vít D deficiency is common among older people, especially frail elderly living in OAHs.
- Measurement of vit D (25(OH)D) level should be done only for those at risk or with symptoms/signs of vit D deficiency.
- Vít D defícíency should be replaced.
- For vit D replete older people, no strong evidence vit D supplement can benefit sarcopenia, prevent falls, reduce fractures, prevent Alzheimer's Disease
- J or U shape curve High dose vit D (>2000 IU per day or in high dose bolus) should probably be avoided.
- Maintenance with vit D 800 IU to 1000 IU seems to be effective (and safe) to most of our local elderly patients.


